

Gaddy-Hamrick Art Center and the Frankie G. Weems Gallery: A Suggested Visual Schedule

1.



Parking

We are going to visit Gaddy-Hamrick Art Center. There are handicap-accessible parking spaces in front of the building. There is also additional parking in front and on the left side of Gaddy-Hamrick.

Entrance

There is a sidewalk with a curb-cut that will lead us to the entrance of the building. We will see a set of two double doors that are

automatic. We will press a blue and white, square button to the left of the entrance in order to open both sets of doors.

Inside Gaddy-Hamrick

When we enter through the doors, the administration's office is in front of us to the center-right.

Restrooms

To our left, there is a hallway where restrooms are located. When we take a left and go down the hallway, the restrooms will be located on our right. The first restroom on our right is the men's

room. The men's bathroom is not wheelchair accessible. The second restroom on our right is the women's room, which is wheelchair accessible.

The Frankie G. Weems Gallery

When we first enter Gaddy-Hamrick, we will make a right, proceed down a short hallway, and then take another right to arrive at the gallery door. During gallery hours, the door to the gallery will be left open. Inside the gallery will be the current exhibition. We can walk through the gallery to explore the art on display.
