

The Frankie G. Weems Gallery at Meredith College features the work of Paige Greeley. Greeley received a BFA in Fine Arts from Endicott College and an MFA in Painting + Drawing from Ohio University, where she was awarded the Presidential Medal of Creative Excellence.

“BEAUTY AS CURRENCY” examines Greeley’s experience as a Western woman and analyzes her previous adherence to the concept of “beauty as currency.” Combining her advocacy work on a sexual assault crisis hotline and her own exploitation, she creates visceral and figurative oil paintings that examine the perennial dangers of “beauty as currency” and the abuse it inflicts on women. Greeley currently works as a birth doula in Philadelphia, supporting new mothers and parents in pregnancy, children, and postpartum.
